### KILOSA DISTRICT – MOROGORO REGION

#### THE CoST INITIATIVE

CoST, the Infrastructure Transparency Initiative, which is hosted by the National Construction Council (NCC), aims at enhancing transparency and accountability in the implementation of public infrastructure projects in order to achieve value for money. The Initiative is multi-stakeholder and involves the three major stakeholder groups i.e. public, private and CSOs.

CoST activities include:

- a) Sensitising Public Procuring Entities to disclose infrastructure projects reports in order to create public understanding of the projects;
- b) To assist PEs to disclose data to the public;
- c) To undertake assurance of the disclosed data;
- d) To sensitise and involve all stakeholders in the monitoring of transparency and accountability in implementation of public infrastructure projects;
- e) To design and implement capacity building programmes aimed at enabling stakeholders to participate in activities aimed at enhancing transparency and accountability in public infrastructure projects;
- f) To monitor policies and legislation and advise on improvements that will enhance transparency and accountability.

#### TARURA

In this disclosure phase CoST is collaborating with the Tanzania Rural and Urban Roads Agency (TARURA) to disclose data on projects in Gairo and Kilosa Districts in Morogoro Region.

#### AIM OF SHARING ROADS PROCUREMENT DATA WITH VILLAGES

- a) To inform beneficiaries about the projects so that they are prepared to extend collaboration to and build good relations with the Agency;
- b) To sensitise beneficiaries to share information that will enable the Agency improve project implementation. The information may include:
  - i) Trouble spots;
  - ii) Conflict of interest with citizens affected by the road project;
  - iii) Source of materials such as water, fill materials, etc.
  - iv) Environmental issues;
  - v) Sources of Labour; and
  - vi) Information that will improve project implementation to make sure they are built with value for money in order to make sure the public gets functional infrastructure..

# WHAT IS CoST?

## What is CoST?

The Construction Sector Transparency Initiative (CoST) is a global initiative working with governments, the private sector and local communities around the world to get better value for money in public infrastructure investments through increased transparency and accountability.

## CoST STRUCTURE

### Participation

CoST Tanzania is a multi-stakeholder initiative with members from the public, private and civil society sectors. CoST membership is open to institutions and private individuals who believe that transparency and accountability in public infrastructure delivery will enable achievement of value for money.

### Annual General Meeting

The main decision making body is the Annual General Meeting

### Multi-Stakeholder Group

CoST has a multi-Stakeholder structure whereby the three sectors each elect three representatives to the Multi-Stakeholder Group (MSG). The representatives of the three groups are:

- a) The Public Sector represented by the National Construction Council (NCC), the National Audit Office, Prevention and Combating of Corruption Bureau (PCCB) and the National Housing Corporation (NHC). three sectors are:ina mfumo wa Wadau Mtambuka (Multi-Sectoral) ambapo wanachama wamewekwa katika makundi makuu matatu ambayo huchagua wawakilishi kwenye Kamati ya Wadau (Multi-Sectoral Group - MSG). The Champion of CoST Tanzania is the Minister responsible for Good Governance. Currently it is the Minister of State, President's Office, Public service Management and Good Governance.
